PPH Program Implementation Workshop:

To provide implementing agencies with the knowledge and tools for successful implementation of PPH Prevention Programs using a comprehensive approach to PPH prevention at homebirth and the facility

USAID's flagship Maternal and Child Health Integrated Program (MCHIP) is organizing a three-day workshop for non-governmental organizations and implementing partners. The workshop will focus predominantly on implementation approaches for preventing PPH at homebirth using misoprostol. It will also provide partners with the knowledge and tools for successful implementation of a comprehensive approach to PPH prevention using strategies for births either at home or in a facility.

The workshop will provide a forum for NGOs working in countries with a high maternal mortality burden and feature a series of interactive learning sessions and discussions.
